



## Luciana Calvin will be representing Brazil in the World Photographic Cup



Luciana's image "Treasure Hunting", will be representing Brazil in the Portrait Category in the World Photographic Cup in Rome, Italy.

"OMG, I am over the moon. This has been my biggest achievement by far, the one I am most proud of after the Boston Marathon", said Luciana.

"Three or four years ago at Imaging, I was watching the awards ceremony for the first time and they called the USA team on the stage. I thought that was sooo cool and that someday I want to be as good as those people; it then became a goal, a motivator to get better at print comp."

"Brasil didn't have an organized guild until a couple of years ago, and since it became an official guild they had won first place in 2020 and second place last year. Now they have a qualifying competition specific to qualify photographers for Brazil's team."

Luciana will be at the Awards Ceremony at Imaging USA, as she is also a Grand Imaging Awards finalist for the same image. "If there is a year for me to be at Imaging it definitely is this year. Independent of the results of GIA or the WPC, I am in a higher place than I have ever been, so whatever comes my way,

finalist or not, it is still going to be one heck of a journey!!!"

Starting from November 6th, and until November 26th, 35 nations will compete for the Cup in the 9th edition of this unique photographic competition. The images will be judged by a panel of more than 30 international judges from around the world. Top 10 photographers in each of the six categories and 35 Best of Nation images will be announced LIVE from Imaging USA, during the Grand Imaging Awards & World Photographic Cup Presentation, on Monday, January 17th, 2022.


